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Figure 1: CIE and NCEA pathways

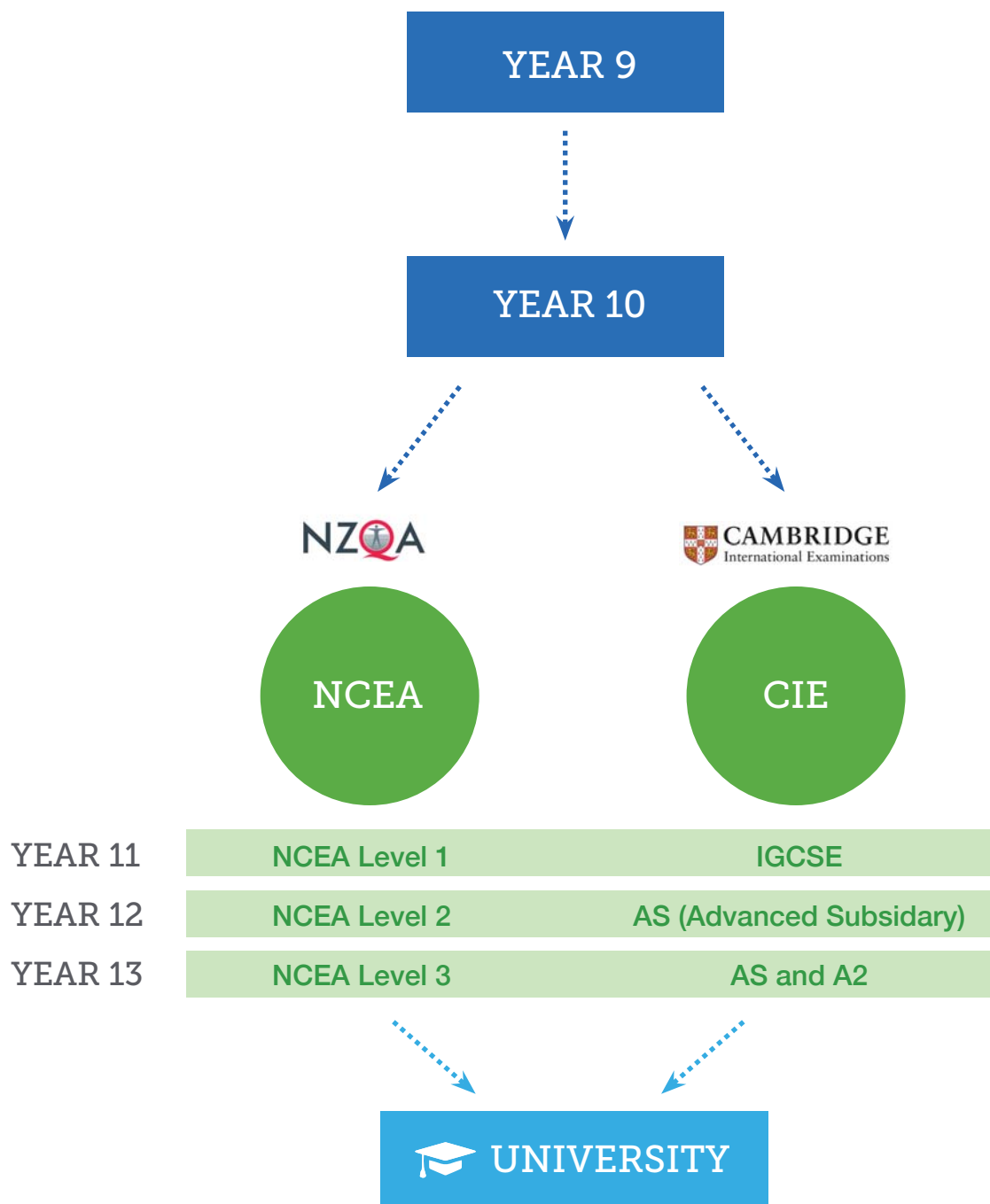


Figure 2: The CIE pathway

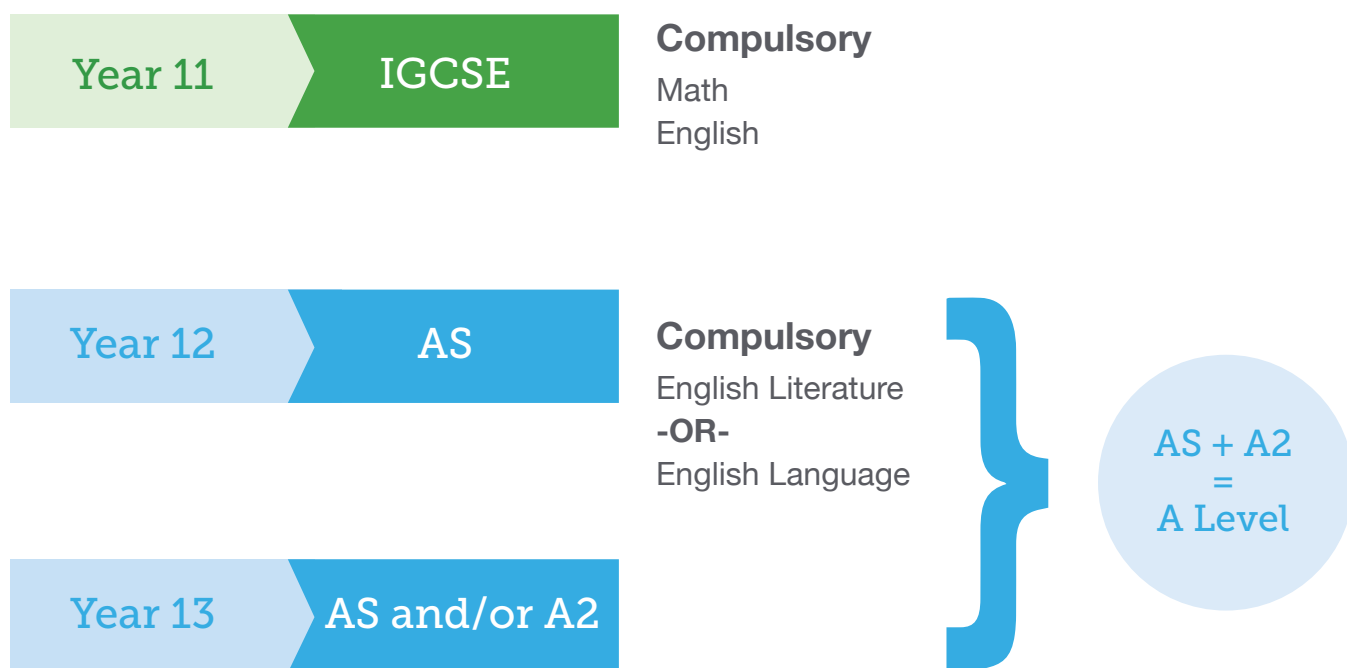


Figure 3: Sample CIE exam calendar

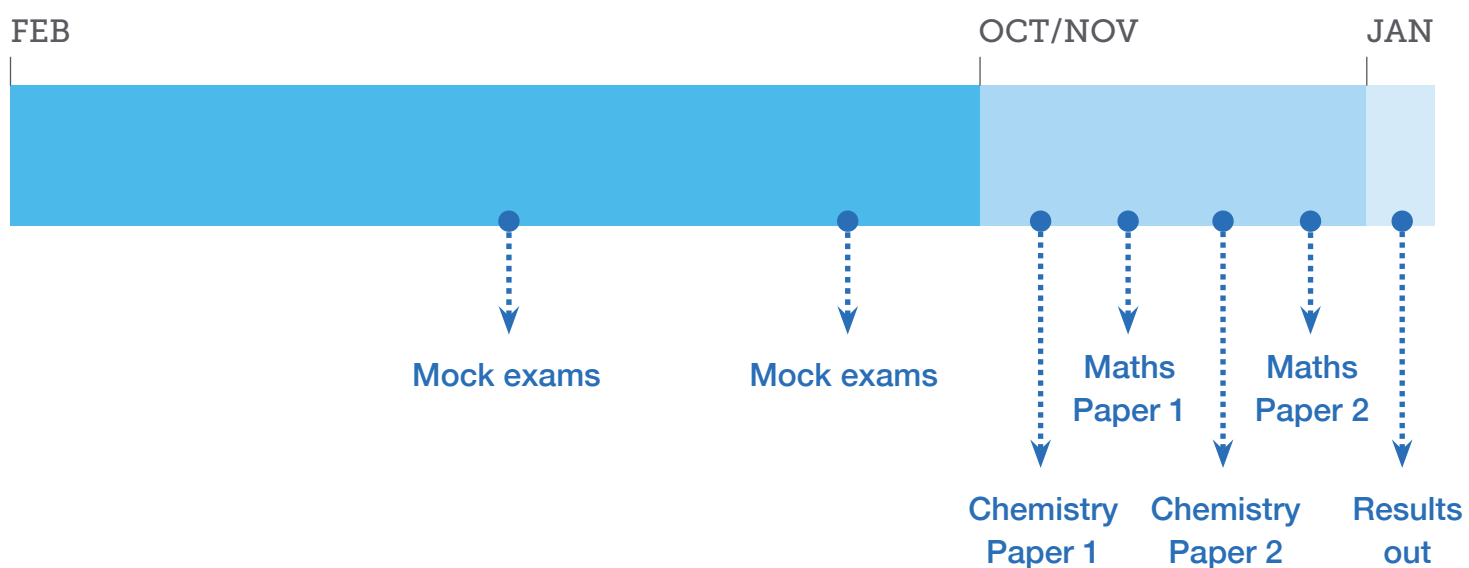


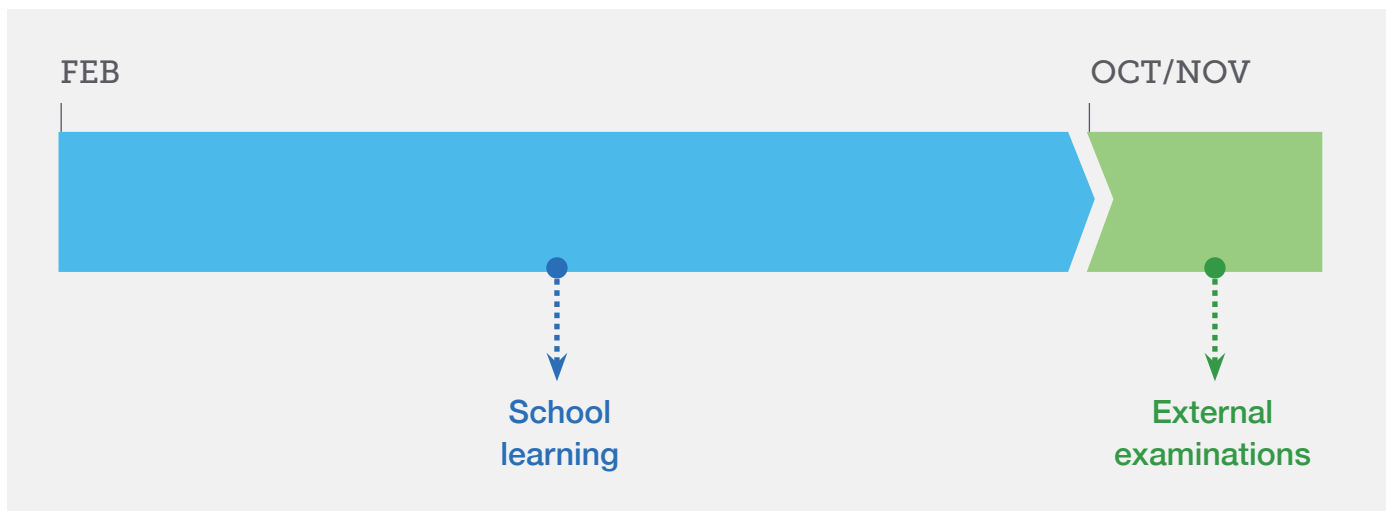
Figure 4: CIE grade thresholds

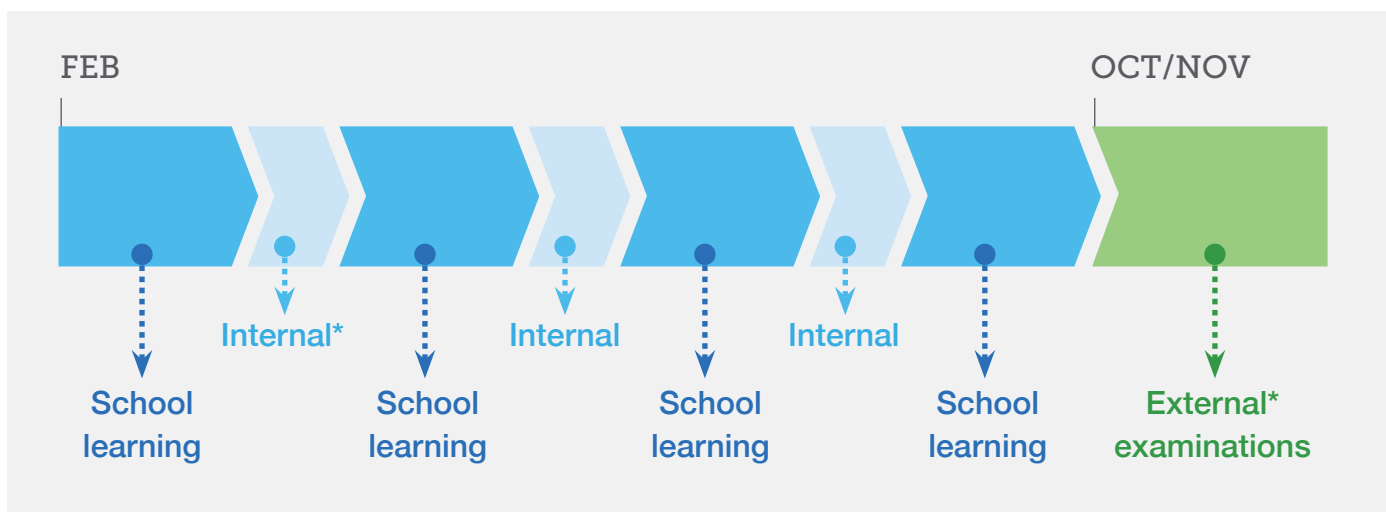

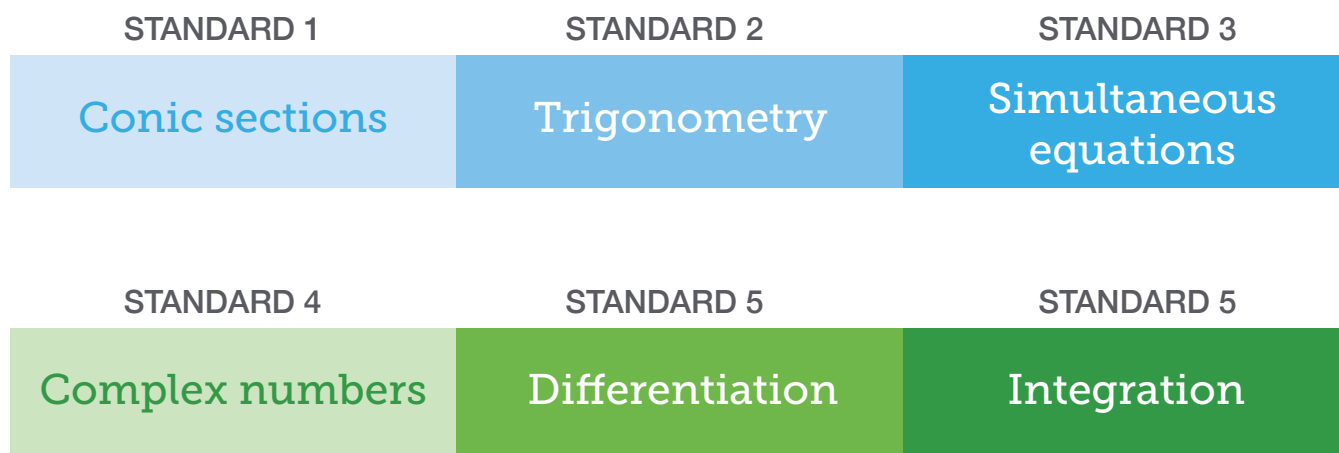

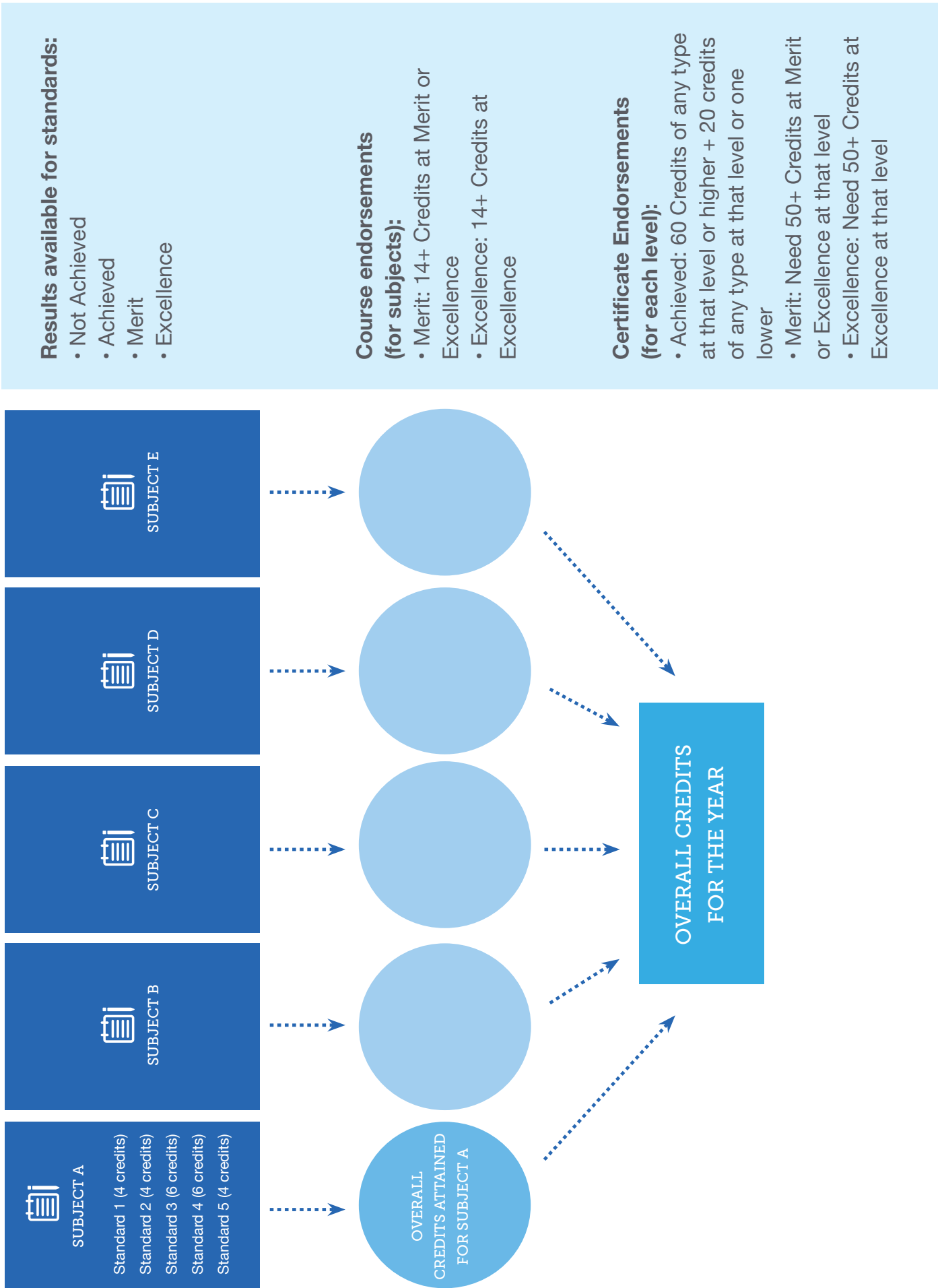


Figure 8: University entrance

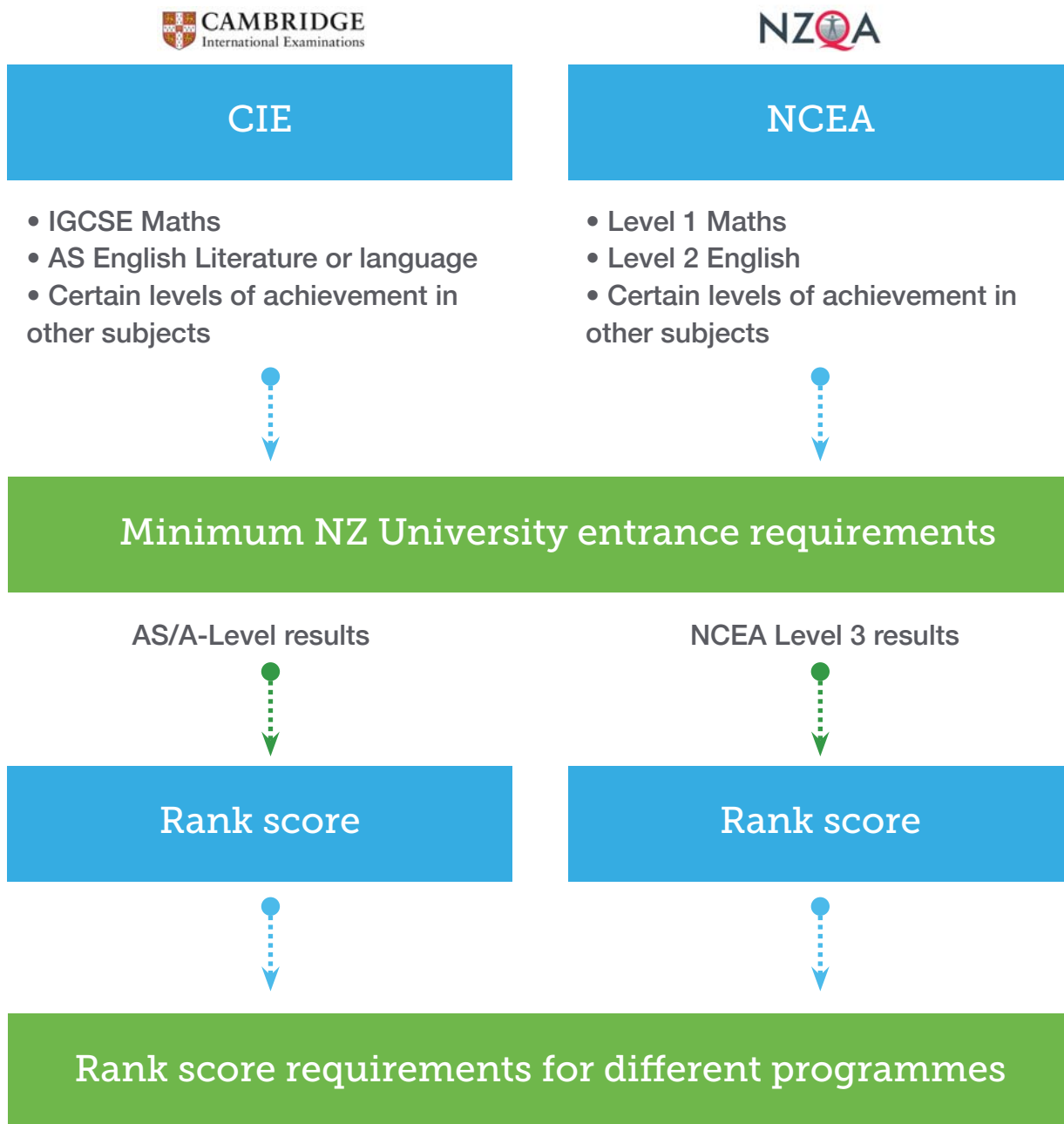
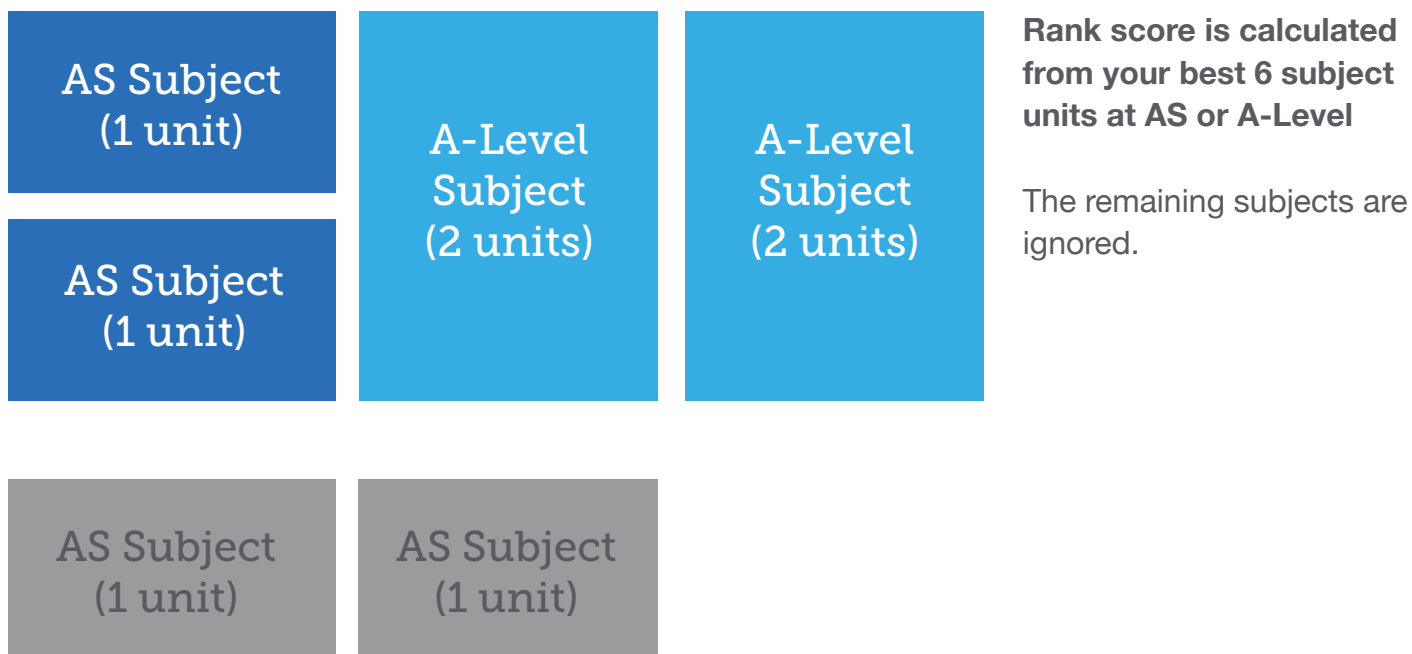


Figure 9: Calculating your rank score

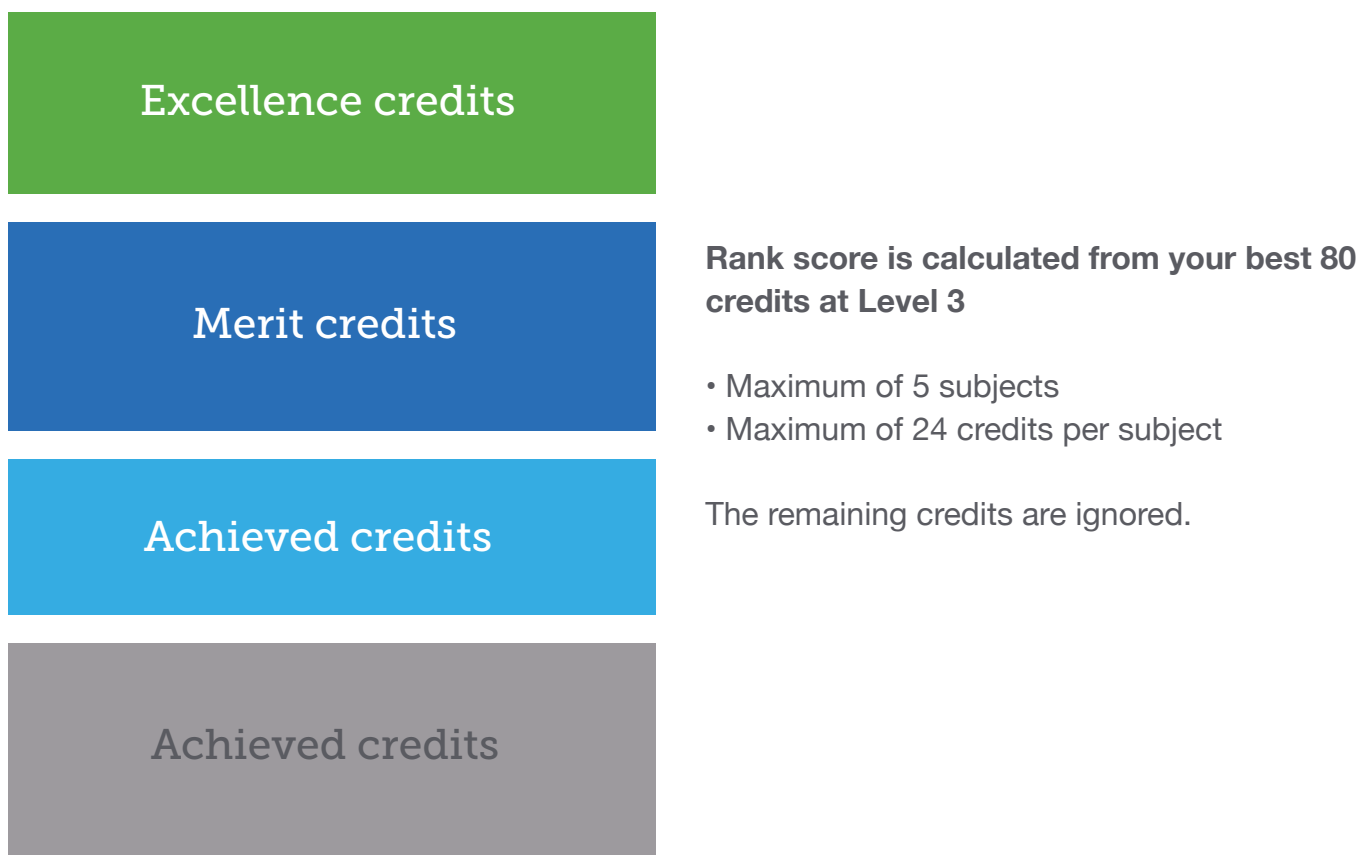


Figure 10: University of Auckland programme requirements

Bachelor of Architectural Studies (BAS)	230	280
Bachelor of Health Sciences (BHSc)	250	300
Bachelor of Engineering with Honours (BE Hons)	250	310
Maximum Possible	320	420
